

Notification of account number for pension payment

The National Government Employee Pensions Board (SPV) use Swedbank for payment of pensions. This means that you must notify your bank account for payment of pension to Swedbank's account register (regardless of bank). A Swedish bank account can easily be registered at www.swedbank.se/kontoregister or by filling out this form. Account in a foreign bank can only be registered with this form.
